HEBREW WORDS FOR GOD'S WORD IN PSALM 119

תּוֹרָה /*torah*/ 'directions' (for a journey)

"Come, let us go up the mountain of the Lord, to the house of the God of Jacob, so he can give us the *directions* of his ways so we can walk in his paths." – Micah 4:2

דָּבָר /*davar*/ 'word' (written or spoken)

"Now the whole earth had one language, and the same set of *words*." – Genesis 11:1

מִשְׁפָּט /*mishpat*/ 'decisions' (from a judge)

"Shall not the Judge of all the earth make *decisions* with justice?" – Genesis 18:25

עֲדוּת /*edot*/ 'promises' (of the covenant)

"The *promises* of the Lord are sure." – Psalm 19:7

מִצְוָה /*mitzwah*/ 'commands' (of the law)

"showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my *commands*" – Exodus 20:6

חֻקֵּי /*chaqaq*/ 'prescriptions' (from a doctor)

"If you will take all my *prescriptions*, I will put none of the diseases on you that I put on the Egyptians, for I am the Lord, your Healer." – Exodus 15:26

פְּקָדִים /*paqad*/ 'instructions' (with detail)

"The Lord God of heaven has given me all the kingdoms of the earth. He has given me *instructions* to build a temple for him in Jerusalem, which is in Judah." – 2 Chronicles 36:23

אָמָר /*amar*/ 'sayings' (memorable quotes)

"My child, if you receive my commands, and store my *sayings* in your heart... then you will understand how to fear the Lord, and you will discover knowledge about God." – Proverbs 2:1,5
