- ❖ *Once you have been served, please take the elements back to your seat. We will eat and drink together once everyone has been served.*

Crates for Ukraine Update

CTK is planning to send two church members to Krakow, Poland at the end of August to courier humanitarian aid to churches in Ukraine. The couriers will bring twelve crates filled with requested supplies. You can help fill these crates by (1) picking up a tag Sunday morning and returning the item to church; (2) by purchasing items from our Amazon Wish List; and (3) by making contributions to CTK with 'Crates for Ukraine' on the memo line. The cost of crates and airfare is estimated to total \$6,000 per courier. Funds are available to match your financial gifts to this project dollar-for-dollar up to \$6,000.
