*<sup>16</sup> For he shatters the doors of bronze and cuts in two the bars of iron.*

*<sup>17</sup> Some were fools through their sinful ways, and because of their iniquities suffered affliction;<sup>18</sup> they loathed any kind of food, and they drew near to the gates of death.*

*<sup>19</sup> Then they cried to the LORD in their trouble, and he delivered them from their distress.*

*<sup>20</sup> He sent out his word and healed them, and delivered them from their destruction.*

*<sup>21</sup> Let them thank the LORD for his steadfast love, for his wondrous works to the children of man!<sup>22</sup> And let them offer sacrifices of thanksgiving, and tell of his deeds in songs of joy!*

*<sup>23</sup> Some went down to the sea in ships, doing business on the great waters;<sup>24</sup> they saw the deeds of the LORD, his wondrous works in the deep.<sup>25</sup> For he commanded and raised the stormy wind, which lifted up the waves of the sea.<sup>26</sup> They mounted up to heaven; they went down to the depths; their courage melted away in their evil plight;<sup>27</sup> they reeled and staggered like drunken men and were at their wits' end.<sup>28</sup> Then they cried to the LORD in their trouble, and he delivered them from their distress.<sup>29</sup> He made the storm be still, and the waves of the sea were hushed.<sup>30</sup> Then they were glad that the waters were quiet, and he brought them to their desired haven.<sup>31</sup> Let them thank the LORD for his steadfast love, for his wondrous works to the children of man!<sup>32</sup> Let them extol him in the congregation of the people, and praise him in the assembly of the elders.*

## GOD FEEDS US FROM HIS WORD

\*SERMON TEXT

Matthew 8:23-9:8

*<sup>23</sup> And when he got into the boat, his disciples followed him. <sup>24</sup> And behold, there arose a great storm on the sea, so that the boat was being swamped by the waves; but he was asleep. <sup>25</sup> And they went and woke him, saying, "Save us, Lord; we are perishing." <sup>26</sup> And he said to them, "Why are you afraid, O you of little faith?" Then he rose and rebuked the winds and the sea, and there was a great calm. <sup>27</sup> And the men marveled, saying, "What sort of man is this, that even winds and sea obey him?"*

*<sup>28</sup> And when he came to the other side, to the country of the Gadarenes, two demon-possessed men met him, coming out of the tombs, so fierce that no one could pass that way. <sup>29</sup> And behold, they cried out, "What have you to do with us, O Son of God? Have you come here to torment us before the time?" <sup>30</sup> Now a herd of many pigs was feeding at some distance from them. <sup>31</sup> And the demons begged him, saying, "If you cast us out, send us away into the herd of pigs." <sup>32</sup> And he said to them, "Go." So they came out and went into the pigs, and behold, the whole herd rushed down the steep bank into the sea and drowned in the waters. <sup>33</sup> The herdsmen fled, and going into the city they told everything, especially what had happened to the demon-possessed men. <sup>34</sup> And behold, all the city came out to meet Jesus, and when they saw him, they begged him to leave their region.*

*<sup>1</sup> And getting into a boat he crossed over and came to his own city. <sup>2</sup> And behold, some people brought to him a paralytic, lying on a bed. And when Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralytic, "Take heart, my son; your sins are forgiven." <sup>3</sup> And behold, some of the scribes said to themselves, "This man is blaspheming." <sup>4</sup> But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, "Why do you think evil in your hearts? <sup>5</sup> For which is easier, to say, 'Your sins are forgiven,' or to say, 'Rise and walk'? <sup>6</sup> But that you may know that the Son of Man has authority on earth to forgive sins"—he then said to the paralytic—"Rise, pick up your bed and go home." <sup>7</sup> And he rose and went home. <sup>8</sup> When the crowds saw it, they were afraid, and they glorified God, who had given such authority to men.*
